



PALACE ON WHEELS TRAIN TOUR

DAY ONE: Delhi – Jaipur

Your journey of a lifetime aboard this luxury train – originally built for royalty – begins with a warm, traditional welcome before the Palace on Wheels pulls out for the night.

DAY TWO: Jaipur – Jaisalmer

Your first stop is the Pink City of Jaipur, the capital of Rajasthan. You will be taken by air-conditioned coach to Hawa Mahal, the Palace of the Winds, before continuing on to the Amber Fort. Here you will ride elephants, and shop for Jaipur's famous jewellery, handicrafts, blue pottery and textiles. After lunch at a Palace Hotel, you will visit the elegant City Palace and Jantar Mantar observatory. You will return for dinner on board, and depart in the early evening for Jaisalmer.

DAY THREE: Jaisalmer – Jodhpur

Jaisalmer lies in the heart of the Thar Desert. Its yellow sandstone fort is an imposing sight, towering magnificently over the city. After exploring the fort, you will have time to shop at Rajasthali – the only Rajasthan Government emporium with fixed prices – for fine pattu shawls, mirror work, jewellery and curios. After lunch on board, you will embark on an exciting camel ride on the sand dunes of Sam, before enjoying dinner and cultural programmes at a hotel in Jaisalmer. The train departs for Jodhpur tonight.

DAY FOUR: Jodhpur – Sawai Madhopur

Today you will explore Jodhpur, a city ringed by a high stone wall, and its Mehrangarh Fort and the grand palaces within. You will have some time for shopping, and after lunch at a royal Palace Hotel, you will return to the Palace on Wheels and depart Jodhpur.

DAY FIVE: Sawai Madhopur – Chittaurgarh

After breakfast, you will visit Ranthambore National Park, the wildlife sanctuary considered the country's best for observing and photographing the activities of the tiger. The park contains ruins of a 10th century fort, and is also home to hyena, ratel, jackal, fox and over 300 species of bird. After lunch on board, you will arrive in Chittaurgarh in the afternoon. Images of love and valour; scars of battles lost and won – Chittaurgarh Fort is all this and more.

DAY SIX: Chittaurgarh – Udaipur – Chittaurgarh

Today a luxury coach will take you to the lake city of Udaipur. Perhaps two of the most beautiful sites are the dreamlike marble palaces, Jag Niwas (Lake Palace) and Jag Mandir, which appear to rise from the blue waters of Lake Pichhola. After lunch, you will visit the City Palace, before being taken back to the Palace on Wheels in Chittaurgarh.

DAY SEVEN: Chittaurgarh – Bharatpur – Agra – Delhi

Early the next morning, the Palace will arrive in Bharatpur, where you will visit the world famous bird sanctuary of Keoladeo Ghana National Park, before departing for Agra. In the afternoon you will visit Fatehpur Sikri or Red Fort, the red sandstone palatial complex. After lunch you will continue to the majestic Taj Mahal, a pristine and astounding monument of undying love. Following dinner on board, you will depart for Delhi.
